Objectives

- To bring together providers of emergency pre-hospital care from all over the country; sharing experiences and developing networks for future cooperation
- To develop standards in the provision of pre-hospital care and ensuring common knowledge and application of these standards
- To initiate an on-going process emphasizing the provision of high-quality pre-hospital care for the community

Competition Structure

All Team will undergo 4 mode of assessment as below

Computer Based Scenarios Assessment

Each team will send 2 members to take part. 15 minutes will be allocated for training and familiarization, and another 15 minutes for actual assessment. Candidates will be tested their knowledge and decision making on the computer simulated scenarios.

Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)

Each team will send 2 members to take part. 60 minutes will be allocated for the 60 MCQ assessments. Participant will be tested on knowledge relevant to pre-hospital care.

Skill Assessment Station

At the skill assessment station, participant will be assessed on their ability in management and administration of treatment of Medical, Trauma and Resuscitation cases.

Extrication

All team members will participate. Team will be required to extricate a trap victim in passenger car. Team will be access on scene control, full spinal & lower limb immobilization, oxygen supplement, lifting and moving techniques.

Equipment provided : Full Spinal Board, Neck Collar, Splints, Bandages, Ambulance Cot, Oxygen Tank complete with Bag-Valve-Mask, Oxygen Face Mask.

Equipment & Disposable required for the competition will be fully provided the organizer. Detail list of the equipment and disposable provided will be announced 1 week after closing date.

2. Each team to be comprised of 4 members, with minimum age of 18 on 30th November 2009. Participant must be a pre-hospital care practitioner and able to perform skill to be assessed (please refer below for more information)
3. Entry of this competition is by using the form provided by the organizer, complete with participation fee. Entry form must get endorsement of representing organization.
4. Closing date of this competition is 30th November 2009.
5. Change of Team members is allowed with a written notice to organizer, at least 2 days before the competition.
6. Attire during the competition is respective organization / team **Uniform**.
7. Participant will be quarantined during the competition. Participant can only communicate with or through the Marshall.
8. Communication device of any kind is not permitted during the competition.
9. Only Equipment or item provided by organizer can be utilize during the competition.
10. All team must complete their assessment during the time allocated.
11. Panel Judges will be appointed by organizer. Judge will be invited from various Pre-hospital Care providers' organization.
