St. John Ambulance of Malaysia, Penang State (SJAM Penang), is pleased to invite members of the media to witness the launch of its Highway Ambulance Service under Ops Selamat, to be held on **14 February 2026**, in conjunction with the Chinese New Year festive period.

The Highway Ambulance Service Emergency Response Team (ERT) is a nationwide multi-agency initiative involving the Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM), Road Transport Department (JPJ), Fire and Rescue Department, St. John Ambulance, and Subtek. The operation will be deployed at nine strategic locations nationwide.

For Penang, SJAM Penang's Emergency Medical Ambulance Service (EMAS) will be stationed at 3 designated locations: **Section N3, Sungai Dua Toll Plaza, SJAM Penang Headquarters and SJAM Penang Relau Base HOTPOST**, providing rapid medical assistance and emergency response support to highway users throughout the operation period.

SJAM Penang Launches Highway Ambulance Service for Ops Selamat 2026

Penang, 14 February 2026 - St John Ambulance of Malaysia, State of Penang (SJAM Penang) today officially launched its Highway Ambulance Service under Ops Selamat 2026 in conjunction with the Chinese New Year festive season.

Representing the Right Honourable Chief Minister of Penang, The Honourable Daniel Gooi Zi Sen officiated the launch ceremony held at Wisma St John Ambulans.

Ops Selamat is a nationwide multi-agency initiative involving the Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM), Road Transport Department (JPJ), Fire and Rescue Department, St John Ambulance, and Subtek, aimed at enhancing road safety and emergency preparedness during peak travel periods.

In 2025, SJAM Penang deployed three ambulances with 28 members and medical personnel, responding to 72 emergency cases. Of these, 35% were motor vehicle accidents, 40% medical cases, and 5% required CPR intervention.

For Ops Selamat 2026, SJAM Penang will expand its deployment to four ambulances supported by 37 members, covering 96 operational hours across two sessions (14-16 February and 20-22 February 2026). Coverage locations include Section N3 near Sungai Dua Toll Plaza, Wisma St John Ambulans, and Relau Hotspot Ambulance Base.

SJAM Penang reaffirmed its commitment to rapid emergency response and public safety under its motto, "For the Service of Humanity."

SJAM Pulau Pinang Lancar Perkhidmatan Ambulans Lebuhraya Ops Selamat 2026

Pulau Pinang, 14 Februari 2026 – St. John Ambulans Malaysia Negeri Pulau Pinang hari ini melancarkan Perkhidmatan Ambulans Lebuhraya di bawah Ops Selamat 2026 sempena sambutan Tahun Baharu Cina.

Majlis pelancaran telah disempurnakan oleh YB Daniel Gooi Zi Sen yang mewakili YAB Ketua Menteri Pulau Pinang.

Pada Ops Selamat 2025, SJAM Pulau Pinang telah menggerakkan tiga buah ambulans dengan 28 orang anggota dan petugas perubatan serta menangani 72 kes kecemasan.

Bagi tahun 2026, sebanyak empat ambulans dengan 37 orang anggota akan ditempatkan di Seksyen N3 berhampiran Plaza Tol Sungai Dua, Wisma St. John Ambulans dan Relau Hotspot Ambulance Base, melibatkan 96 jam operasi dalam dua sesi (14-16 Februari dan 20-22 Februari 2026).

Inisiatif ini mendukung kesiapsiagaan kecemasan dan keselamatan pengguna jalan raya sepanjang musim perayaan, di bawah moto “Perkhidmatan bagi Manusia”.

槟州圣约翰救护机构启动 2026 年“安全行动”高速公路救护车服务

槟城，2026 年 2 月 14 日 - 马来西亚圣约翰救护机构槟城州分会今日正式启动 2026 年“安全行动”（Ops Selamat）高速公路救护车服务，配合农历新年期间的交通高峰期。

槟州首席部长代表，槟州行政议员魏子森主持了启动仪式。

在 2025 年行动期间，槟州圣约翰救护机构共派出 3 辆救护车及 28 名队员，处理 72 宗紧急事故，其中 35% 为交通意外，40% 为医疗个案，5% 涉及心肺复苏（CPR）急救。

2026 年将增至 4 辆救护车及 37 名成员，在双溪赖收费站附近 N3 路段、圣约翰槟州总部及湖内热点救护车基地驻守，总服务时数达 96 小时。

槟州圣约翰救护机构重申秉持“为人类服务”的宗旨，全力保障公众安全。

Terlebih dahulu, saya ingin merakamkan penghargaan kepada St. John Ambulans Malaysia Negeri Pulau Pinang atas komitmen berterusan dalam menyokong agenda keselamatan jalan raya negeri dan negara.

Kerajaan Negeri Pulau Pinang sentiasa memandang serius aspek keselamatan awam, khususnya ketika musim perayaan yang menyaksikan peningkatan ketara aliran trafik di lebuhraya. Justeru, kerjasama antara agensi kerajaan dan pertubuhan sukarela seperti SJAM adalah amat penting dalam memastikan sistem respons kecemasan berada pada tahap kesiapsiagaan yang tinggi.

Saya difahamkan bahawa dalam Ops Selamat 2025, SJAM Pulau Pinang telah menggerakkan tiga ambulans dengan sokongan 28 anggota dan petugas perubatan. Sepanjang tempoh operasi, sebanyak 72 kes kecemasan telah ditangani, merangkumi kemalangan kenderaan bermotor, kes perubatan serta kes yang memerlukan bantuan CPR. Pencapaian ini membuktikan keberkesanan perancangan strategik dan kecekapan pasukan di lapangan.

Kerajaan Negeri merakamkan setinggi-tinggi penghargaan kepada semua sukarelawan dan petugas yang telah berkhidmat tanpa mengira waktu, termasuk ketika orang ramai menyambut perayaan bersama keluarga.

Bagi Ops Selamat 2026, saya dimaklumkan bahawa operasi akan diteruskan secara lebih tersusun dan strategik, melibatkan tiga lokasi utama termasuk Seksyen N3 Lebuhraya Utara-Selatan berhampiran Plaza Tol Sungai Dua. Langkah ini selaras dengan usaha berterusan Kerajaan Negeri dalam memperkukuh jaringan keselamatan awam dan meningkatkan tahap respons kecemasan.

Kerajaan Negeri akan terus menyokong inisiatif seperti ini kerana keselamatan rakyat adalah keutamaan bersama. Saya berharap usaha murni ini bukan sahaja meningkatkan keselamatan pengguna jalan raya, malah menyemai semangat kesukarelawanan dan tanggungjawab sosial dalam kalangan masyarakat.

Dengan ini, saya merasmikan Pelancaran Perkhidmatan Ambulans Lebuhraya St. John Ambulans Malaysia Negeri Pulau Pinang di bawah Ops Selamat 2026.

Ladies and gentlemen.

It is my honour to welcome you to the launch of SJAM Penang's Highway Ambulance Service under Ops Selamat 2026.

Allow me to begin by reflecting on last year's operation.

During Ops Selamat 2025, SJAM Penang deployed three ambulances supported by 28 trained members and medical personnel. Operating from Wisma St John Ambulans and the Relau Hotspot Ambulance Base, our teams responded to a total of 72 emergency cases.

Of these cases:

- 35% involved motor vehicle accidents (MVA),
- 40% were medical emergencies, and
- 5% required CPR intervention.

These statistics clearly demonstrate the critical need for immediate medical support along major highways during festive seasons. As a medical doctor, early intervention

often makes the difference between life and death, and I am extremely proud of our volunteers who responded with professionalism, discipline and compassion.

Building on that experience, we are strengthening our deployment for Ops Selamat 2026.

This year, SJAM Penang will deploy four ambulances supported by 37 members. Our operations will span 96 hours over two sessions:

- 14-16 February 2026
- 20-22 February 2026

We will cover three strategic locations:

1. Section N3 of the North-South Expressway near Sungai Dua Toll Plaza,
2. Wisma St John Ambulans, Grove Road, and
3. Relau Hotspot Ambulance Base.

This expanded deployment enhances our coverage, reduces response time, and increases our operational resilience.

I wish to record our sincere appreciation to the State Government of Penang for its continued support, as well as to PDRM, JPJ, the Fire and Rescue Department, and all collaborating agencies. Most importantly, I thank our volunteers and medical personnel who sacrifice their festive celebrations to serve others.

St John Ambulance remains steadfast in our mission — For the Service of Humanity.
